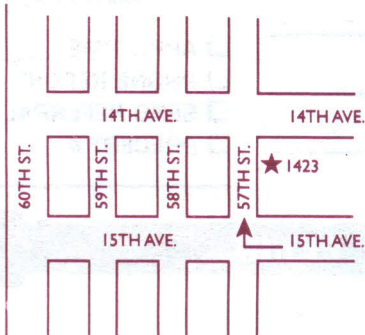
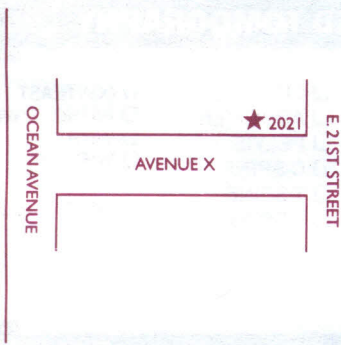

PET/CT

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Do not eat anything for at least 4 hours before your exam.
- If you take Medications, take them with water only.
- If you need to drink water, you may do so moderately.
- Do not exercise 24 hours before, or day of exam.
- No Alcoholic Beverages.

WARNING: DO NOT STOP REGULAR ORAL MEDICATION

If you are a diabetic using insulin, bring a light snack with you.

MRI SCAN

Most MRI scans do not require preparation. If preparation is necessary for your procedure, you will be informed when you schedule your exam. Depending on the part of your body being scanned, an MRI takes approximately 30 minutes.

MAMMOGRAM

Wear a two-piece outfit. Do not use deodorant, talcum powder or perfume on the underarms or breasts on the day of the exam.

Bring previous mammograms for comparison.

BONE DENSITOMETRY

No calcium supplements, vitamins, dairy products, or osteoporosis medications (on day of exam).

IVP (INTRAVENOUS PYELOGRAM)

Do not eat or drink for 4 hours prior to the exam.

HYSTEROSALPINGOGRAM

Call Radiology Associates to schedule an appointment on your first day of your menstrual cycle. Take 2 Tylenols an hour before your appointment.

NUCLEAR MEDICINE PROCEDURES

BARIUM ENEMA

You will need to purchase a Prep Kit from our office. Start prep one day before exam and follow instructions. Stay on clear liquid diet day before exam.

ABDOMINAL SONOGRAM & GALLBLADDER SONOGRAM

Do not eat or drink 4 hours prior to exam.

C-T: HEAD, NECK, CHEST, ABDOMEN, PELVIS

An injected contrast may be used. Do not eat or drink for 4 hours before exam.

UPPER GI SERIES; ESOPHAGRAM; SMALL BOWEL SERIES

Do not eat or drink after midnight the night before the exam. An upper GI Series takes approximately 1 hour. A small bowel series takes 1 to 6 hours.

PELVIC, BLADDER, OBSTETRICAL SONOGRAM

Eat normally. Beginning 1 hour prior to your exam drink 5 (8 oz.) glasses of any liquid. Do not urinate after drinking the liquid.
